



Climate Policy

1. Introduction

Baguio Green Group Limited ('Baguio') is committed to enhancing the capability in tackling climate change, and managing its impacts that give both risks and opportunities to our integrated environmental services. We will implement and enforce sustainable principles to create long-term values for our shareholders, stakeholders and community.

2. Scope of Application

This Climate Change Policy (the 'Policy') – adopted by the Board of Directors of Baguio – applies to Baguio and its subsidiaries, collectively referred to as the 'Group'. Since the Group offers a wide range of environmental service including Professional Cleaning, Recycling, Waste Collection and Management, Green Technology, Green Product, Horticulture and Landscaping, and Integrated Pest Management, the Group requires a clear and comprehensive statement of its commitments in tackling climate change across its operations. Each subsidiary of the Group should use this Policy as a guidance for developing its management approach and practices in ways that are most appropriate to its industry and location.

3. Commitments

We strive to:

- Reduce our carbon footprint through the establishment and implementation of long-term carbon emission reduction targets, including reducing 30% carbon intensity and 30% energy intensity by 2030 compared to 2016, and to recycle 60% of our non-hazardous waste by 2030;
- Comply with all legal requirements to minimise the environmental impact caused by carbon emission;
- Encourage all stakeholders to reduce carbon emission in their daily operations wherever practicable;
- Promote and disseminate climate change knowledge among all stakeholders to enhance climate literacy;
- Incorporate climate change considerations in our procurement processes and encourage the use of low-carbon and energy-efficient products and materials;
- Increase the use of renewable energy and low carbon energy source where applicable;





- Evaluate and analyse climate risks to our business and take advantage of the opportunities that may arise;
- Incorporate climate change and extreme weather events into our business operation and continuity plans, establish contingency measures that are monitored and reviewed regularly to prevent or minimise potential damage;
- Track, report, and manage all traits of our sustainability performance in our core business.

4. Monitoring and Reporting

We are committed to enhancing the execution and effectiveness of the Policy. We assess and report our sustainability performance in line with local listing requirement on Environment, Social and Governance disclosure. Stakeholders are regularly engaged to opine about our capability in tackling climate change and the effectiveness of the Policy.

5. Review of the Policy

A review of the Policy shall be conducted every three years or more frequently as and when needed. Where there are any discrepancies or differences of interpretation in the Policy between the English text and Chinese translation, the English version shall prevail.
